## DOG LICENSE

**ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED BY APRIL 1:**

This is an annual license and must be purchased each year.

Dog license are valid from January 1 to December 31.

LICENSE RATES ARE:

Male & Female	\$8.50	Neutered Male & Spayed Female	\$3.50

**ANYONE THAT HAS 4 OR MORE DOGS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A KENNEL LICENSE OR MULTIPLE DOG LICENSE**

Multiple Dog License (Up to 12) \$36.50

Owners must present their **RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE** that their dog is vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian before the dog can be licensed. I also need a phone number for Dog license report sent to the Brown County Clerk's Office. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED!!!!**

THE PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE INCLUDED ON THE TAX BILL. ANY QUESTIONS, PLEASE CONTACT EITHER THE BROWN COUNTY TREASURER'S OFFICE OR JEANNE CONARD, TREASURER FOR TOWN OF HUMBOLDT.

Explanation of charges from the Town on your tax bill: \$50 fee is for use of the drop off recycle/garbage center; \$100 fee is for capital expenditures for the New Franken Fire department – mainly replacement/purchase of fire trucks and equipment.
